An Act to amend an Ordinance, No. 14 of 1849, for the making and improving of Roads in South Australia.

[Assented to 18th December, 1851.]

WHEREAS by an Ordinance, No. 14 of 1849, certain roads are declared to be main roads, and it is expedient to provide that certain district roads may, from time to time, be declared main roads for the purposes of that Ordinance:

Preamble.

Be it therefore Enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, That the lines of roads set forth in the Schedule hereunto annexed shall be, and they are hereby, declared to be main lines of road of the Province, for all the purposes of the aforesaid Ordinance No. 14, 1849.

Governor may proclaim district roads to be main roads.

SCHEDULE REFERRED TO.

MAIN LINES OF ROADS.

1. The North Road, by Gawler Town to the Burra; with North-eastern Branch from Gawler Town to Moorundee; and North-western Branch to Clare.
2. The North-eastern Road, through Gumeracka; with branch on the South side of the River Torrens.
3. The Eastern Road, from Adelaide by Magill, through the Tiers, to join the Main Line of Road No. 9.
4. The South-eastern Road, *viâ* Hahnsdorff and Mount Barker, to Wellington; with South Branch to Strathalbyn.
5. The South Road; Western Branch, to Yankalilla and Cape Jervis; Eastern Branch, to the Meadows and Encounter Bay.
6. The Bay Road, to Glenelg.
7. The Port Road.
8. The Road from Kooringa to Port Wakefield.
9. The Road from Cox's Creek, through Balhannah, by Mount Torrens, to Reedy Creek Mine.
10. The Old North Road, from O'Connell-street, North Adelaide, by the Windmill, by Gepps' Cross, to the junction of Main North Line at the Dry Creek.
11. The Road from the "Grand Junction Hotel," on the North Road, to the North-east angle of Albert Town, to the Causeway and the present Port.
12. Road to and by Unley.
